

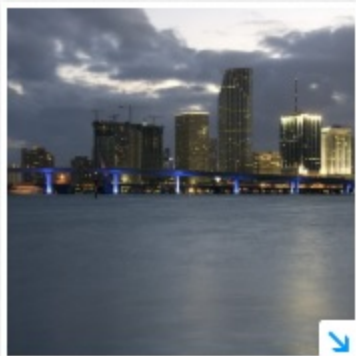


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Places to Go Out in Brickell, Miami

La Centrale: A Foodie's Paradise

Food halls show no signs of slowing down. New in 2018, La Centrale brings a slice of Italy to the heart of Brickell. The food hall is home to 14 eateries, plus five lively cocktail and wine bars, providing a seamless continuation from appetizers to dinner to drinks. Of course, save room for dessert at Gelateria by Venchi, a gelato shop that has two chocolate fountains – one milk chocolate, the other dark chocolate – to dip your cones in and delight your sweet tooth. Or for a unique night out, try a cooking class at La Cucina, which offers everything from pizza workshops to an aperitivo masterclass.

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
